Besides the Master's degree, the applicant must hold a Bachelor's degree from any recognized and accredited university.

- a. A holder of a Bachelor of Science degree with at least an upper 2 nd class honours with Zoology or Botany as a single subject or as one of the two (2) science subjects.
- b. A holder of a Bachelor of Education degree who has studied Zoology or Botany to degree level and has attained an upper 2 nd class honour degree.
- c. A holder of a Bachelor degree in any other relevant areas of study such as Geography and Environment with at least an upper 2 nd class honours degree and has taken units relevant to degree program.

A holder of Bachelor's degree with a lower 2 nd class may be accepted provided they can produce evidence of a mean score of 'C' in relevant Subject.
